FOLLOWING JESUS: Climb the Cliff!

GETTING STARTED

- Are you more of a "Thrill Seeker" or a "Comfort Seeker"? Why?
- Have you ever run an obstacle course or climbed a cliff? What was that like? How did you feel when you accomplished it...or did you?
- Is there anything in this week's message that caught your attention, challenged you or confused you?

DIGGING DEEPER

- 1. Read 1 Samuel 14:1-23. When Jonathan "hatched" his plan with his armor-bearer, the response was (vs. 7) "Do what you have in mind... Go ahead; I will be with you heart and soul." How has having an "all in" companion helped you?
- 2. What obstacles did Jonathan and his armor-bearer have to overcome to be victorious? What gave them courage to "Climb the Cliff"?
- 3. When have you faced a real challenge that took determination and/or courage? What was it that gave you the strength and determination to face that challenge? Did you have doubts? If so, how did you "move ahead"?
- 4. What current "cliffs" do you think God wants you to climb for Him? How is your current response comparing with Jonathan's? With his armor-bearer's?
- 5. You could say that Jonathan's behavior had a level of "expectancy" (vs. 6) of what God would do. How would you evaluate your current "expectancy level"? Why does this matter as part of "following Jesus"?
- 6. Do you believe God would ever ask you to do something He has not equipped or prepared you for? Does that mean it will always turn out like we want? Explain.

TAKE AWAY

- What is a challenge you are facing right now where God is asking you to "climb the cliff"? Is there anything holding you back? Who are some "armor-bearers" who will climb the cliff with you and take a step this week towards God's will?
- 2. How can people be praying for you this week?

(1 Samuel 14:23a) 1 Samuel 13:16-14:16 "Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit," says the LORD Almighty. (Zechariah 4:6b) Hearing God call us to go "all in" with Him: 1. Die to self/Pick up 3. Climb 2. Burn the ships the Cliff your cross daily... Break the bottle... Trust in Him... ...Follow Jesus ...No turning back ...Move ahead ... I will build My church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it. (Jesus, in Matthew 16:18b) Jonathan: Perhaps the LORD will act in our behalf. Nothing can hinder the LORD from saving, whether by many or by few. Jonathan's young armor-bearer's statement: What "cliff" is God asking me to climb? Go ahead; I am with you heart and soul. Do I truly believe He is able to save...whether by the powerful or by me? When did we start believing that Jesus died to keep us safe? He died Do I have any "armor bearers" with me? to make us dangerous! The will of God is not an insurance plan. It's a daring plan. When will I move ahead with Him? Cf. Psalm 46
