*Reflections on Revelation 3:14-22 ...*

*The Four S's as a Pattern of "Door-opening" living **WITH** Jesus*

**S**\_\_\_\_\_ : Finding time to actually  
be *alone* with Jesus.

*Consider Jesus' example in Mark 1:35-38 and Luke 5:15-16*

**S**\_\_\_\_\_ : Learn to listen to  
Jesus. He may be talking ... really!

*Look further into the context and impact of 1 Samuel 3:10, Psalm 46:10,  
and 1 Kings 19:11-13*

**S**\_\_\_\_\_ : This is His voice, His  
words to you / us. Read it and find life with Jesus.

*Powerful commentary is found in 2 Timothy 3:16 and surrounding verses.  
Consider also Colossians 3:16 and Hebrews 4:12*

**S**\_\_\_\_\_ : A day set-apart to be  
with and enjoy Jesus together.

An alternative S\_\_\_\_\_

*First modeled in Genesis 1-2, take some time to reflect on what Jesus has  
to say about this practice, which is in fact the 4th Commandment  
(Deuteronomy 5:12)*

For further reading on life *With* Jesus, take a look at the book titled *With* by Skye Jethani. I (Spence) lean heavily on Jethani's ideas in this message and have found this particular book very helpful. This would make a great small group study.
