Heidelberg Catechism

Written in 1563 in Heidelberg, Germany

• Effort to unify teachings at time of Reformation

• Later, in 1618, endorsed as confession of Reformed faith

What Heidelberg Catechism is not...

Replacement of the Bible

Inspired Word of God

What Heidelberg Catechism is...

- 129 questions explaining doctrinal truths of Bible
- Written in way to teach next generation
- Compiled in 52 "Lord's Days", to teach weekly
- Great tool to guide you through foundational truths
- As an example, Lord's Day 1...
 - 1. What is your only comfort in life and in death?

"That I am not my own, but belong - body and soul, in life and in death - to my faithful Savior Jesus Christ...."

(21 "proof text" from Bible to back that up)
