Sunday's Main Scripture Text: Romans 9:1-33

Digging Deeper: (Teachers/leaders, feel the freedom to NOT ask every question.)
Read over Romans

- 1. In verse 3 Paul says that if he could, he'd accept the curse of being cut off from Christ for the sake of the non-believing Jews. Why does he care about them so much? Do you think we have enough compassion for those who don't yet know Jesus?
- 2. How do we live "fully dependent upon and submissive to God's Word?"
- 3. What does God's sovereignty mean to you and how does it affect your life?
- 4. If God chooses us, and "salvation belongs to the Lord", what responsibility do we have in helping Him build His church?
- 5. Have you ever prayed the sinner's prayer with someone? If yes, please share. If not, why do you think that is?
- 6. Paul writes about the doctrine of 'justification by faith alone' (again) in verses 30-33. At this point in our Anchored series, is this something you fully understand and can explain? (Law vs. Grace + Works vs. Faith, etc.)
