Sunday's Main Scripture Text: Exodus 20 and Deuteronomy 5:6-21 The first 6 Commandments

Digging Deeper: (Teachers/leaders, feel the freedom to not ask every question.)

Read aloud Exodus 20:2-23

- 1. Pastor Al revealed these first five commandments have a theme. Do you agree that they all do? Can you explain what that theme is and why it is important?
- 2. Which one of these specifically affects your family if you disobey it? Why do you think this one in particular does that?
- 3. What has been your history with the 10 Commandments? What do you remember about them as you were growing up?
- 4. Read in Deuteronomy 5:22-29. What is it that Moses is saying about the people's response? What is the heart of God for His people?(vs 29)
- 5. Is there anything confusing about God's will regarding His commands?
- 6. How does fearing God(vs. 29) relate to the first 5 commandments and does that really make sense or is it confusing to you?
- 7. How can you "fear God" in your relation to these commands, this week?

Apply it today: Looking back over this week's teaching, what is most important for you to remember and why? How will you grow in the area you have identified?
