SUNDAY'S MAIN SCRIPTURE TEXT:

Luke 4:1-30 "Temptation and the Holy Spirit"

DIGGING DEEPER: (Teachers/leaders, feel the freedom to **not** do every question)

- 1. Luke 4 starts right after Jesus' baptism. How did He determine to go into the wilderness and why would He go into an uncomfortable circumstance like that, only to be tempted 40 days? Does that make sense to you? Luke 4:1-2
- 2. Luke 22:31-34 refers to a conversation Jesus had between Himself and Satan, about Peter. Why would Jesus allow Satan to do that to Peter and the disciples and what similarities do you see between Luke 4 and this passage?
- 3. How would you respond if you were led into a "wilderness moment" by the Holy Spirit? Would anyone want to describe one of these times you had?
- 4. Pastor Al also spoke about Jesus being led by the Holy Spirit to do battle in advancing God's kingdom. How are you led by the Holy Spirit?
- 5. How can you look more like Jesus this next week in your efforts to "advance God's kingdom"? Think about all that Jesus went through to accomplish this.
