Opener Question or Activity: What was the hardest thing you can remember about being a child? If you're a parent, what was the hardest thing about parenting?

Sunday's Main Scripture Text: Deuteronomy 6:4-9, Ephesians 6:1-4
Digging Deeper: (Teachers/leaders, feel the freedom to not ask every question.)
Read Deuteronomy 6:1-9 together.

- 1. What are vrs. 1-3 saying, in your own words? Try not to use any of the words from the text in explaining what this passage says.
- 2. How would you explain to a friend your objective in parenting is to teach children to "fear the Lord your God...by keeping all His decrees and commands..."? How would a non-believing world respond to this?
- 3. What are the examples of ways good parenting impacts a society? What are the examples of this you can point to today?
- 4. How could you engage non-Christians who hear this teaching, or others like it from Scripture(Proverbs 22:6, 15, Colossians 3:20, Ephesians 6:1), and would doubt or question its validity? Discuss ways to have healthy discussions.
- 5. Re-read vrs. 6-9. How do you follow through, in our day and age, with implementing these things? Are you to really tie them on your hands and foreheads, and doorframes of your homes?
- 6. Read Malachi 2:15 Why or why not should you raise godly children intentionally or allow them to develop their own faith by chance?

Apply it today: Looking back over this week's teaching, what is most important for you to remember and why? How will you grow in the area you have identified?
