Main Scripture Text: Esther 4:9-17, Other texts: Ps. 139:16, Eph. 2:10

Digging Deeper

(Review this weeks passage and discuss some deeper questions related to it)

- 1. What was the dilemma Esther faced?
- 2. What, in our day, would cause you to be faced with a moral dilemma?

(Esther would break the law to approach the king, on behalf of her people.)

- 3. Read verse 14 again. What, would you say, was Esther's cousin (2:7) Mordecai really saying to her? What message was he conveying? Discuss
- 4. Esther's decision to speak on behalf of others could have cost her life. But what would you say was the reason she did it? Have you had the opportunity to speak on behalf of others, even if it might cost you something? Describe
- 5. How do you show your readiness to do God's will and work?
