Sunday's Main Scripture Text: Luke 18:15-30

Digging Deeper: (Teachers/leaders, feel the freedom to not ask every question) Read Luke 18:18-30

- 1. What were the things this rich ruler felt confident in regarding his right to inherit eternal life (vs. 18-21)?
- 2. Jesus' words in vs. 22 saddened the ruler because he was rich, but is there an underlying reason he could not accept Jesus' direction?
- 3. What was Jesus' point in asking him to sell all his possessions and give them to the poor? Is this the key to eternal life or not (John 3:16)?
- 4. Being rich and entering the kingdom of God is a heavy topic as Jesus makes clear in vs. 24-25. How do you feel about it being more difficult to enter the kingdom of God if you have wealth? Do we have wealth in the west? How can I be certain I'm not being deceived by my wealth?
- 5. Describe together your understanding of how a person enters the kingdom of God and eternity? Use scripture.
- 6. How does Jesus assume a follower of His lives based on vs. 29-30?
- 7. If you could summarize Jesus' whole point in this passage, how would you?

Apply it today: Looking back over this week's teaching, what is most important for you to remember and why? How will you grow in the area you have identified?
