Sunday's Main Scripture Text: Luke 9:21-27 - Follow

Digging Deeper: (Teachers/leaders, feel the freedom to not ask every question)

Read Luke 14:25-35 together

- 1. How would you feel if you were in the "large crowd" and heard the words Jesus spoke, specifically in vrs. 26-27? What do you think He means?
- 2. What are the "crosses" you may carry in your life(vs 27)?
- 3. Jesus uses two analogies to bring His point home in vrs. 28-32. Why would Jesus use these analogies to help understand counting the cost of following Him?
- 4. Look at vs 33 and discuss how giving up everything applies for us today.
- 5. At the end of this passage, Jesus brings up salt as a metaphor. It can be physically diluted or contaminated to lose its saltiness. How does a Christian maintain his/her saltiness?
- 6. When you review this passage, what is the one thing that is staying with you about being a disciple for Jesus?

Apply it today: Looking back over this week's teaching, what is most important for you to remember and why? How will you grow in the area you have identified?
