Matthew 16:13-20

- Compliment, don't condemn.
- We are not sheriffs (looking for compliance).

2) Are you keeping _____?

1 Corinthians 13:4-8:

Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It is not rude, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. Love never fails.

3) Are you _____ to know others and be "with" them?

Matthew 1:23:

"The Virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and they will call him Immanuel" - which means, "God with us."

John 1:14 MSG:

The Word became flesh and blood, and moved into the neighborhood...
