SUNDAY'S MAIN SCRIPTURE TEXT:

"Uncluttered", A Study on Wisdom from Proverbs 8

DIGGING DEEPER: Read Proverbs 1:1-7 together.

- 1. Who is the writer of these proverbs according to vs 1 and what is significant to this? 1 Kings 3:3-15 sheds important insight into this significance.
- 2. What words in Proverbs 1:1-7 help describe or interpret what wisdom is and provides?
- 3. Think about one person from your life whom you find is one of the wisest. What makes them wise and what words from these vrs remind you of them?
- 4. Does higher education bring about wisdom? Why or why not? What have been your greatest experiences in "gaining wisdom and instruction for understanding words of insight"? School, family, experiences, etc?
- 5. Look at vs 7. Why would Solomon say the "Fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge..."?(Ps. 11:10 also) What ways should believers fear the Lord?
- 6. What other people in the Bible can you recall, who "Feared God"? How would they be considered wise?
- 7. Reflecting on all 7 vrs, are there ways you can apply this proverb to your life in the coming week? Would anyone care to share how?
