GETTING STARTED

Who is this Jesus? - Wonderful Counselor

"Wonderful." The Hebrew word *pala* indicates "a phenomenon lying outside the realm of human explanation; that which is separated from the normal course of events." The same word is used in Psalm 139:6 in just this way: "Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; it is high, I cannot attain it." It describes something miraculous!

- 1. Are we as astonished by the Wonder of the Counselor as Isaiah was? Read Isaiah 9:6
- 2. What evidence do we have that Jesus is the Wonderful Counselor? What do we know about Christ?
- 3. As God incarnate, how does Jesus understand our weaknesses?

DIGGING DEEPER

- 1. Read Colossians 2:3, 8-9.
- Jesus demonstrated His abilities in knowing people. Refer to John 1:47-48
 & 2:25
- 3. Read James 1: 5. Do you need wisdom? Take some time and ask for it.
- 4. Read Hebrews 4:16.
- 5. Read Hebrews 10:25. Community should motivate us to encourage each other, love one another, and do good works.

TAKE AWAY

- 1. God cares for and comforts the broken-hearted through His people (1 Corinthians 12:25). If one person is suffering, we are all suffering.
- 2. Take some time this week and let God counsel you through His word and prayer.
- 3. How can people be praying for you this week? Avoid isolation and reach out for help.
