Sunday's Main Scripture Text: Matthew 2:13-18 "Christmas through the eyes of the Children of Bethlehem"

Digging Deeper: (*Teachers/leaders, feel the freedom to NOT ask every question.*) Go back and read the Christmas story from Matthew 2:1-18.

- 1. The Wise Men were more accurately Magi Eastern Astrologers, which was a sophisticated scientific study of the celestials(Stars and planets). State some ramifications to their coming to worship the newborn king?
- 2. Is there anything that you could find ironic about who answered King Herod's question in vs 4-6? How knowledgeable were the religious leaders?
- 3. Who are the people you know who have "heard" about Jesus and yet refuse to believe? Why do people refuse, in light of the evidence?
- 4. Herod's response in vs 16-18 is horrific. Why would a loving God predict this act, and allow it to happen? For how long would these people remember this event throughout Bethlehem, let alone Judea?
- 5. How can you respond to the Christmas story as it relates to children? What areas in church help us highlight the importance of children knowing Jesus?
- 6. How has children's ministry impacted you personally, from the past as well as the present? How can you encourage those working with children in the next 3 weeks?
