## Why does the good news of Jesus bring great joy?

1) Jesus is for \_\_\_\_\_.

(v. 10) I bring you good news of great joy that will be for *all the people*.

(John 3:16) For God so loved the world...

(Romans 1:16) I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of *everyone who believes*...

(v. 12) ...You will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger.

2) Jesus is the \_\_\_\_\_, Christ the Lord.

(v. 11) Today in the town of David a *Savior* has been born to you; he is Christ the Lord.(Christ = Messiah/the anointed one)

(John 3:16-17) ...that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him *shall not perish but have eternal life*. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to *save the world* through him.

- He is the one they've been \_\_\_\_\_ for.

Jesus' life fulfilled at least 300 OT prophecies.

(Genesis 3:15) And I will cause hostility between you and the woman, and between your offspring and her offspring. He will strike your head and you will strike his heel.

## What should our response be to this good news?

1) \_\_\_\_\_ in who Jesus is and what he did.

(Romans 10:9-13) That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and *believe in your heart* that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved... for, everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.

2) Joyful \_\_\_\_\_\_ to God.

(v. 13) Suddenly a great company of the heavenly host appeared with the angel, *praising God* and saying, "Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to men on whom his favor rests."
