Sunday's Main Scripture Text: 1 Corinthians 13 - Hope

Digging Deeper: (Teachers/leaders, feel the freedom to NOT ask every question.)
Read Ephesians 3:14-21 together

- 1. What, specifically, does Paul ask God to do for these believers in his prayer for them? (there are multiple things in vrs. 16-20). Which ones resonate with you most?
- 2. How has your prayer life included love directly for other believers, as Paul models? What are the points you see in these verses that may be helpful for you to apply to your prayer life?
- 3. How does Paul describe God's love for us in vs. 18b and how would you describe this type of love to others in your own words?
- 4. Look back over the definition of love in 1 Corinthians 13:4-7 and pick out which one you are good at and which one you need to improve on? With this exercise, you can be encouraged and also challenged to grow in love.
- 5. 1 Corinthians 13:8 states that "love never fails". How do you feel about never failing at love and would Ephesians 3:19-21 have anything to help you in this pursuit? What is the key ingredient to fulfill this type of love(Vs. 20-21)?
