- 1. As Paul speaks to those who are Jews, he makes a statement of accusation. What are the things he accuses the Jews of in vrs. 17-24?
- 2. How does hypocrisy in a religious person affect people who observe that person?(vs. 24) How do you distinguish the difference between genuineness and a hypocrite?
- 3. Read vrs. 25-29 carefully. What is your summary of why Paul spoke about circumcision and how did he redefine what it means to be a Jew?
- 4. How would you define "circumcise your heart"? Read Deuteronomy 10:16 and 30:6 in order to have more direction on this.
- 5. What are some examples you can point to, of genuine heart transformation and regeneration among born again followers of Jesus? What's the evidence?
- 6. How can you begin to change some inconsistent behaviors and attitudes in your Christian life this week?
