## Sunday's Main Scripture Text: Romans 1:1-17

**Digging Deeper:** (Teachers/leaders, feel the freedom to NOT ask every question.) Read Romans 1:1-17 together

- 1. Who shared the gospel story with you first, that you can remember?
- 2. What words or phrases describe how Paul sees and loves those in the Roman church? Look closely from vrs. 8-17
- 3. Is it all about his ministry to them, or does Paul desire something from them also?(vs. 12-13)
- 4. If you are in a ministry to others in your life, what can you take from Paul's letter that you can apply to your ministry? Discuss this together in your grp.
- 5. How would you personally describe "the gospel"?
- 6. Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-8 and point out the elements of the gospel that make it what it is. What is not a part of it?
- 7. Do you ever find people who are confused about the gospel, and yet think they know what it means? What areas are they most confused about?
- 8. What are practical ways you and I can live out the gospel "unashamed", as Paul states in vs. 16? Try answering this using I, me and my statements.
