For help correcting our way of seeing, we need:

1) A standard (e.g. an eye chart) that objectively show us what our vision *should* be.

2) Someone – preferably with good eyesight(!) – to help us get the right kind of lenses to *correct our vision* so we can see the way we should.

- Physical eyesight

- Philosophical eyesight/the way we see “The Big Picture”

“Worldview”: “the sum total of our beliefs about the world, the ‘big picture’ that directs our daily decisions and actions.”  
(Colson/Pearcey)

- Practical eyesight: ways actions flow from our “Big Picture”
