
We hope you will prayerfully consider joining the group of heroes who will make it possible to reach so many more children and their families and neighbors for Jesus!





### **Quick Facts**

- Adds 13,200 additional sq ft
- → Increasing capacity by 300%!
- Adds 2,150 sq ft to Office Building
- Improving reception area, and comfort and safety for our staff
- Adds 2 bathrooms per children's classroom and includes family bathroom
- → Providing ease & comfort
- Triples capacity for EduCare After School Program
- → Allowing for more children to be admitted
- Triples capacity for Kid's Summer Camp
- $\hookrightarrow$  Allowing for more children to be admitted
- Triples capacity for general Children's ministry
- Allowing for more ministries running concurrently
- Adds specifically designed area for children with special needs
- Opening our ministries to largely unserved families
- Includes funding for renovating student & college spaces
- → Further developing and expanding the outreach for these ministries
- Renovates play areas for children
- → Increasing safety & attraction
- Includes large conference room for meetings, care groups, and family seminars.
- → Addressing new needs and training for parents as well as helping those going through seasons of special difficulty
- Includes solar for entire campus
- $\hookrightarrow$  Significantly reducing energy costs
- Funded without any loans
