- 1. Read again vs 35 and 36, What are the categories of need that are being addressed? Are there any you care to share where you were the one in need and how the church(God's people) did or did not help?
- 2. When your life crosses paths with the lives of people who have these needs, how do you think, feel, respond? What about these encounters is difficult for you in this situation or what is easy?
- 3. How do you go about changing the way you respond to those needs when you are confronted with them?
- 4. What motivation do you have that could provoke you to go outside of your comfort zone to reach out to those you do not have a natural affinity with? Motivation either from fear or love?
- 5. What do you do when you feel the tug on your heart, but feel inadequate (Your bucket is empty) and your own need seems too great for you to reach out?
