Sunday's Main Scripture Text 1 John 4:7-16 "Love Even the Difficult People."

Digging Deeper: Read out loud Luke 6:27-35

- 1. Read vs 27-28 again. How would it be possible to treat someone well who was an open enemy, who claims they hate you? Have you ever walked through this with anyone that you would like to briefly explain?
- 2. Read vs 29-30. This appears to speak of physical issues, but what is the underlying principle believers are to follow? How easy is it for you?
- 3. In vs 32-35 talks about credit/reward for responding in love. What does this mean to you? Is this reward a motivation to try to love people in difficult situations?
- 4. Read vs 35. Have you had any God moments where you were able to follow this direction? Would you care to explain how God moved in you?
- 5. In the same verse, we see that God is kind to ungrateful and evil people. What do you think this means?
- 6. Read vs 36 again. Talk once more about God's mercy to you and how that spurred you to be merciful.

Apply it today Looking back over this week's teaching, what is most important for you to remember and why? How will you grow in the area you have identified?
