Sunday's Main Scripture Text: Luke 2:1-14 - "The Angel's Song"

Digging Deeper: A Study in Psalms of Joy

- Read Psalm 16:11. This passage speaks about two expressions of joy along the path of life in God. How much does the world understand this type of joy or what does the world equate as joy?
- 2. Read Psalm 30:5. When we hear that joy comes in the morning, it means that we had to wait through the night. Can you share a time when you waited for God and at the right time He showed Himself? Talk about that struggle and that emotional response when you knew He was taking care of you.
- 3. Read Psalm 43:4. Who does this passage say is the author's joy? Read a few translations of this verse. What are ways people can know God as their joy and delight?
- 4. What would it mean to have a personal "altar of God?" Consider some of the possibilities and discuss together what that would look like and consist of.
- 5. Read Psalm 47:1. Notice two things: clapping and shouting. Discuss what these two have to offer as vehicles of praise and joy in your worship.
