*Opener Question or Activity: Who is a person you trust to do what they say? How did you come to trust this person? How does trust relate to hope?

Sunday's Main Scripture Text: Romans 15 - Hope

Digging Deeper: (Teachers/leaders, feel the freedom to not ask every question)

- 1. One Hebrew word translated "Hope" means to wait, or wait for. Read aloud all of Psalm 31 with this in mind. Look at verses 1 through 5. What are the ways you see the psalmist waiting in hope for God? How have you done any of these?
- 2. In verses 7 and 8, there is hope fulfilled. What is his response to God coming through?
- 3. In verses 9-13, the psalmist describes his trials where he waited and hoped in God. Have you experienced any of these difficulties? How did you maintain hope?
- 4. In Verse 14, the psalmist says "You are my God." How does that declaration give him hope? Have you found hope in declaring the truth?
- 5. Look in verses 15 through 17 for expressions of hope, where the psalmist chooses to hope in God. Which can you relate to?
- 6. From verse 18, how have "lying lips" disheartened you? How did you fight it?
- 7. Verse 22 speaks to momentary failure to hope. What causes this? How have you fought through it?
- 8. Verse 24 gives a recap of what happens when you choose to hope in God. How do you choose hope? What are the results you have seen?

Apply it today: Looking back over this week's teaching, what is most important for you to remember and why? How will you grow in the area you have identified?
