- 2. What do you think it means to be lukewarm, as opposed to hot or cold?
- 3. What's the result of the Laodiceans considering themselves rich? What does Jesus say about the rich in Luke 18:18-27? Do you consider yourself rich and if so, how do these passages relate to you?
- 4. What is the difference between the Laodiceans definition of rich and Jesus' definition?
- 5. What could be the point of Jesus' progression of what to "buy" from Him: gold, white clothes, eye salve? Some verses to add to the discussion would be from 1Peter 1:7, Revelation 19:8, and John 9:41(and surrounding vrs.)
- 6. Knowing this, why would anyone buy from the world's wealth and not from Jesus?
- 7. What did Spence suggest we can do to move beyond being lukewarm to being "with" Jesus?
