Sunday's Main Scripture Text: Luke 23:32-43 "The Thief on the Cross"

Digging Deeper: Luke 23:32-43 "Heart Change"

- 1. In Matthew 27:44 and Mark 15:32 the thief, who believes upon Jesus here in Luke, is seen as a mocker and reviler against Jesus. This thief had a change of heart. Discuss what evidence in the passage reveals his change of heart here in Luke.
- 2. Whether or not you have had a change of heart and trusted in Jesus, think about this question. Can you recall why you didn't have a change of heart earlier in your life?
- 3. This question is related to your story and how and when your heart was changed. Christians call this their "testimony." At this time, go around the group and take time for volunteers to share their testimony! What caused your "eyes to see and ears to hear" for the first time?
