*Opener Question or Activity: Who are you? How can you answer this without telling people your name?

Sunday's Main Scripture Text: Luke 9:28-62 - Misunderstandings About Jesus

Digging Deeper: (Teachers/leaders, feel the freedom to not ask every question)

- 1. Before you became a Christian, what were your thoughts about Jesus? Who did you think He was? What were you accurate or not accurate about?
- 2. Jesus spoke to Paul (previously Saul) in Acts 9:4, asking him, "Saul! Saul! Why are you persecuting me?" Jesus is resurrected at this time. How is Paul persecuting Him by persecuting Christians?

Now read 1Timothy 1:12-17

- 3. What are the ways Paul used to think of Jesus and act towards Him (vs. 13)? What does this say about Paul's understanding(or misunderstanding) of Jesus?
- 4. How is it that God changes our understanding(or misunderstandings) of Jesus, according to what Paul says in 1Tim. 1:13-16?
- 5. What is your story of how God "opened your eyes?" When did you receive mercy and grace to know Jesus personally?
- 6. According to Paul, why did Jesus open his eyes and change his misunderstanding about Him?
- 7. Today, how do you see Jesus differently than before your conversion?
- 8. What could be a couple of reasons God saved you, besides your own personal salvation? Paul was saved for a purpose. What is yours?

Apply it today: Looking back over this week's teaching, what is most important for you to remember and why? How will you grow in the area you have identified?
