- 3. Why do you think this teacher/expert in the law answers the way he does?
- 4. Have you ever seen someone give away extravagant love to a person who was their enemy? If so, when was it and what did it look like?
- 5. If you were to identify with one person in the story of the Good Samaritan, which one would you be and why? Think about this.
- 6. Loving people can sometimes be a challenge. Loving your enemy could be impossible. What is the hardest part of this for you?
