- 1. Can you describe a time in your life where you realized the depth of the love of God that moved you to some type of action? Why did you respond the way you did?
- 2. Read from Ephesians 2:8-9 together. What are the keywords you find in these verses? Why did you choose these keywords?
- 3. What similarities of "the sinful woman" of Luke 7:36-50 and these verses in Ephesians 2:8-9 can you find or connect to her response and why?
- 4. If you haven't yet, look up the word "grace" and discuss its meaning together. How has grace moved you to a deeper love for God?
- 5. Who are the people in your life who have shown you how to live out Ephesians 2:8-9 by the way they love Jesus?
- 6. At the end of Luke 7:50, Jesus says the sinful woman's faith saved her and she should go in peace. How has peace shown up in your life ever since you first believed and were forgiven?

Apply it today: Looking back over this week's teaching, what seems most important for you to remember? Why? How will you grow in the area you have identified?
