GETTING STARTED

Who is this Jesus? – Mighty God

“Mighty” - Fearsome, Powerful, Awesome, Greatness

3. What stood out to you from Sunday’s message on “Mighty God”...what do you remember?

DIGGING DEEPER

1. Skim over or read Job 38-41. Discuss your overall impression of God’s questions to Job?
2. Have you ever “considered” something in creation to the point of reflection on the power of God? Describe
3. Read over John 1:1, 14 and Colossians 1:15-18. Have you ever considered how Jesus was involved in creation and present at the “questioning of Job”? Describe how your view of Jesus should be in light of this.
4. In Colossians 1:18, Paul writes of the “Supremacy” of Jesus. What does supremacy mean to you? Is that a clear definition from the text?
5. Read Hebrews 1:1-3. Who does the author of Hebrews point out speaks to us these days(the last days) and how is He described?

TAKE AWAY

1. What are the ways we can reflect on and know God today? Refer to Hebrews 1:1-3 and Job 38-41 from Sunday’s message.
2. Beyond just reflecting on Jesus life, what areas do you need to make Him have supremacy this coming week? Share with others the honest areas of need in making Him Lord over all.
3. How can people be praying for you this week? Avoid isolation and reach out for help.
